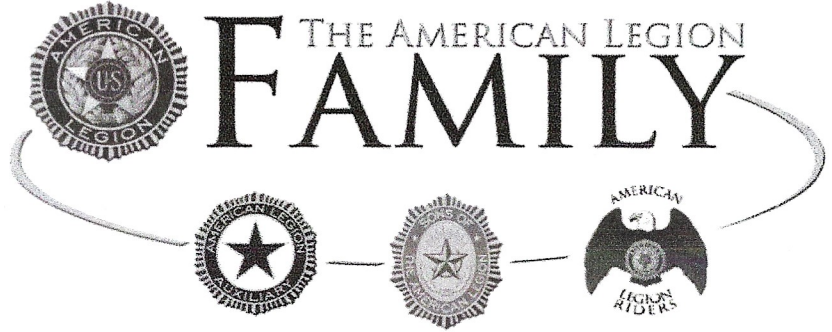

December 7, 1941 started as a beautiful day. a sunny, peaceful Sunday morning. December 7, 1941, 2341 service personal and 49 civilians were lost when Pearl Harbor was attacked by the Japanese. 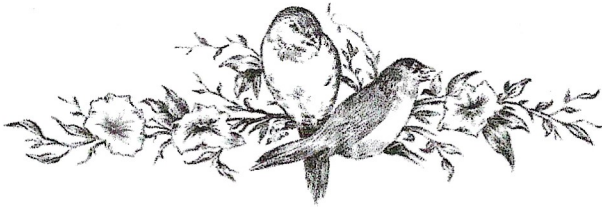

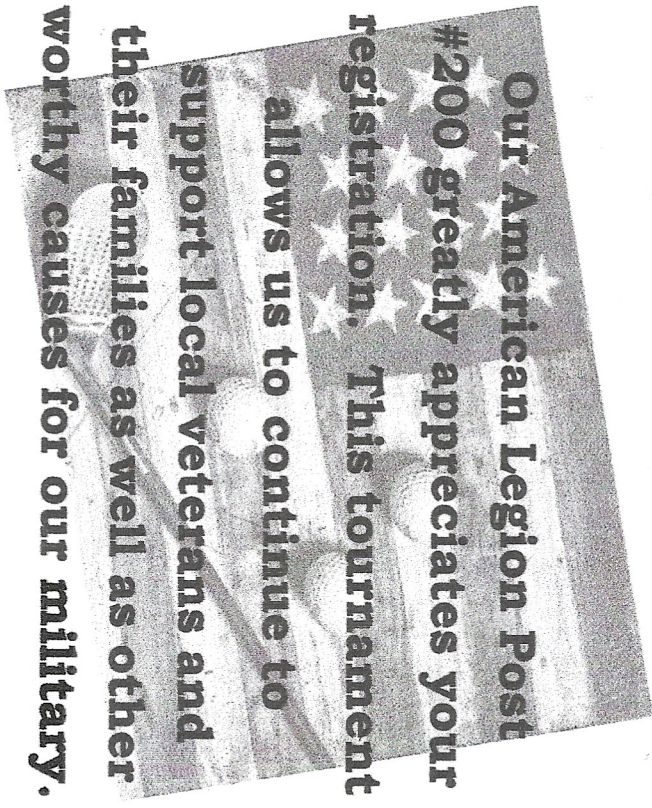

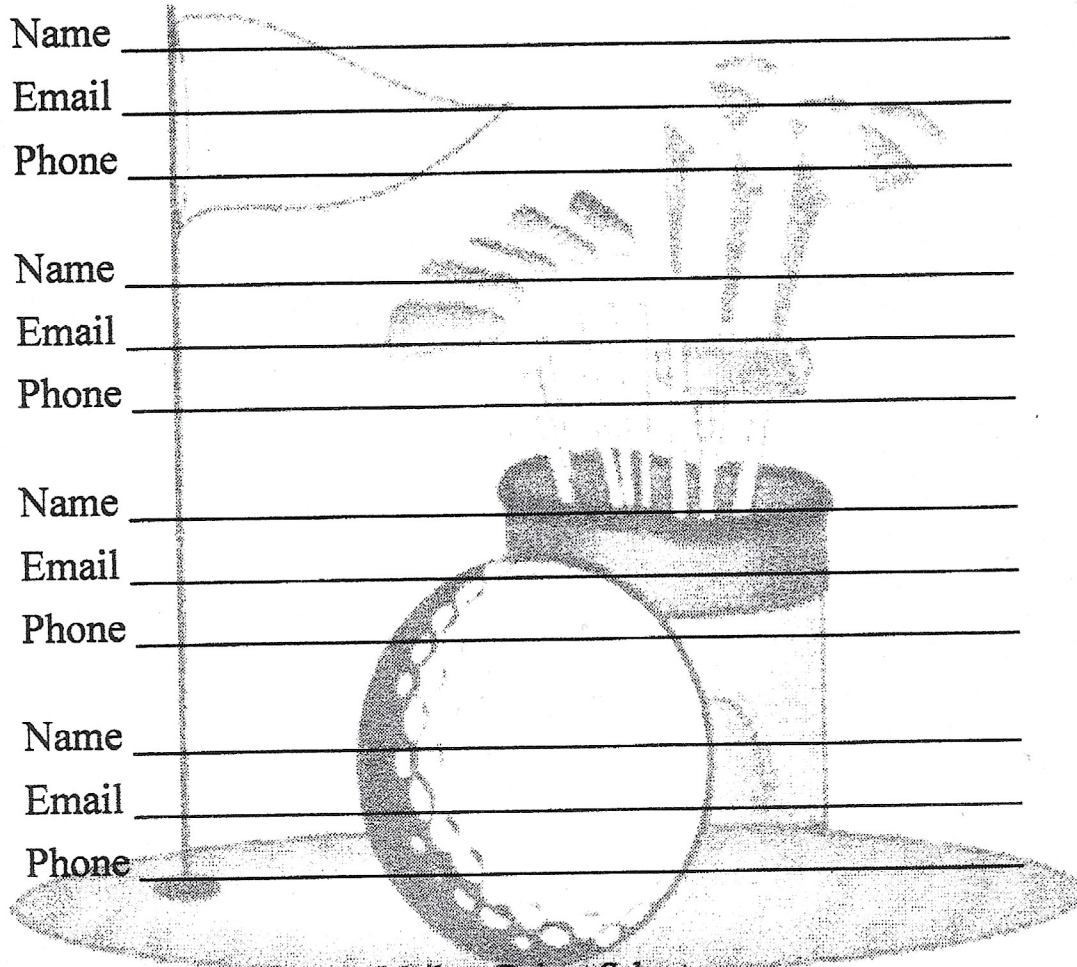
